Building Recording

If proposals have a significant impact on a heritage asset an archaeological building recording may be required. In instances of proposed demolition or substantial remodelling, most buildings over a hundred years old will merit some form of record. There are several different levels of recording. Historic England have produced nationally-applicable best-practice guidelines which will be used to specify what is needed in each particular instance. The Tyne and Wear Archaeology Service will determine the appropriate level of recording and provide the specification for the works.
